To all whom these Presents shall come: I, D.P. Verner, Master in and for the County aforesaid send Greeting:

Whereas Ethel Y. Perry on or about the 13th. day of February in the year of our Lord 1903 exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against W. Beattie Perry, Anna E. Perry, Willie Hayne Perry, Benjamin F. Perry Jr., Hext M. Perry Jr., Elizabeth F. Perry, James V. Perry and Louise B. Perry, the last named individually and as executrix of the last will and testament of William H. Perry deceased, demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 13th. day of October 1903, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be conveyed by D.P. Verner, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the said decree having provided that the commissioners heretofore appointed by this Court do lay off from that portion of the land allotted by them to Louise B. Perry twenty acres including the race tract building, and that the said twenty acres be added to that portion of the land allotted by them to the plaintiff and her child

ren; that the commissioners after so laying off said twenty acres do make new plats of the land partitioned showing said change and to deliver the same to the Master of Greenville County; that upon the receipt of said plats the said Master do execute and deliver to the respective parties deeds in fee to the land allotted to them respectively attaching to each deed the plat showing the lines of the land thereby conveyed; that the defendant Louise B. Perry upon receipt by her of the Master's deed as above provided do pay to the plaintiff or her authorized attorney the sum of Five Hundred Dollars as agreed by the parties that the Master do tax the costs of this action and that the same be paid one half thereof by the defendant Louise B. Perry and the other half thereof by the other party to the action. And the said commissioners having laid off the land as required by the said decree and the said Louise B. Perry having paid the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, and one-half of the costs according to the terms of the said decree.

And the plaintiff and her children having paid one-half of the costs as directed by the terms of the said decree and in all respects complied with the terms thereof.

NOW THEREFORE Know all Men by these Presents, That I, D.P. Verner Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid in consideration of the performance of the conditions aforesaid and the payment of Three Dollars by the plaintiff and her children the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged HAVE GRANTED, bargained and released and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ethel Y. Perry, W. Beattie Perry, Anna E. Perry, Willie Hayne Perry, Benjamin F. Perry Jr., Hext M. Perry Jr., Elizabeth F. Perry and James V. Perry all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the north side of the Buncombe road beginning at a stone 3xn; thence with the north side of the road 14.40 to bend in the road; thence with the road 6.50 to stone 3xo; thence N.32 E.23.75 to a stake 3xo; thence N.56 1/2 W.10.20 to a stake 3xo; thence N.40 E.27.70 to a stake 3xo; thence N.41 E.24.50 to a stone 3xo in the Thompson Road; thence with the road to a corner in the middle of bridge over the East fork of Landston's Creek; thence down said creek to a stake in creek; thence S.32 W.43 to an iron pin 3xn; thence S.58 E.4.40 to an iron pin 3xn.
