All that certain piece, parcel and track of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, partly in the Torn of Greers in the State of South Carolina, containing thirty nine acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit, On the south side of the Southern Railway and branches of Maple Swamp Creek, waters of South Tyger River.
