Lindley, all that certain tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in Oak-Lawn Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, Containing Nineteen acres more or less, with metes and bounds as follows: Beginning on the Grove Road between Pelzer and Grove Station at a stone 3x thence N.52° E. 9 ch. to stone 3x thence S.70° E. 18. 50 ch. to stone 3x thence S.43° W. 9.90 ch to stone 3x thence S.43° W. 12.25 ch to stone 3x thence up Grove Road to the beginning. The above metes and bounds include 3 1/2 acres held by E.L. Seigler to Smith Hughey which 3 1/2 acres is not included in this deed or will.
