To

Whereas, Julius C. Smith late of the above County and State departed this life July 12th 1903, intestate, leaving as his heirs at law his children, who subsequently devised, on the 18th day of July A.D. 1903, executed and delivered their certain Deed of Trust to J.W. Quattlebaum, as Trustee, authorizing him among other powers to sell and convey the property hereinbelow described all of which will more fully appear by reference to said deed of trust which is recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds Greenville County in Vol H.H.H. page 664, to which reference is made:

And whereas, the said Trustee has sold the 1st of land hereinabove described to Wm P. Smith of the City of Greenville, S.C.

Now therefore know all men by these presents, That I, J.W. Quattlebaum, as Trustee, of the City of Anderson, S.C. for and in consideration of the sum of \$400.00 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Wm P. Smith of the City of Greenville, S.C. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Wm P. Smith all that certain 1st of parcel of land just without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, S.C. on the Rutherford St., road, known as 1st N^o 8 of the Kemp property, containing 1 & 3/100 acres more or less, more particularly described in the Deed of Conveyance from Malie J. Kemp to Julius C. Smith, recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Vol. W.W. page 407, to which reference is made for a more particular description of the same, bounded by Fair St., Rutherford St., 1st N^o 7, 1st N^o 9. this deed is also to convey the right, title and interest that I as Trustee, have in the small triangle of land on the right-hand side of Rutherford St., and cut off from 1st N^o 8, to which it formerly belonged.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Wm P. Smith, his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, as Trustee, and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Wm P. Smith, his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs, claiming to claim the same or any part thereof.

Mining Lease G.W. Hawkins

TO

Carolina Monazite Company

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, G.W. Hawkins, of the County and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) dollars, to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by the Carolina Monazite Company a corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal place of business at Gloucester City, N.J., and consideration hereinafter named; have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release for a period of ten years, unto the said Carolina Monazite Co., the right and privilege of digging, prospecting, mining and carrying away all minerals of whatsoever nature or kind, in the bottom lands on and in the branches, creeks, and streams, of all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in the State and county aforesaid, bounded on the north by lands of Chas Ashmore and J.L. Rhodes, on the east by lands of Chas Ashmore, on the south by lands of Walter Cox, on the west by lands of J.D. Harris, being the same tract on which I now live, and known as the Thornton old place; containing 50 acres more or less.

The condition being that the said Carolina Monazite Company shall pay to the said G.W. Hawkins fifty dollars (\$50.00) on the signing of this instrument, and fifty dollars (\$50.00) one year from date hereof, and that the said Co. shall pay the further sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per acre, for every acre of said lands which it may mine; to be paid after the mining is complete; the said Company having the right to take as many acres of the said land as it may wish, but shall pay the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per acre, therefore as above indicated.

And in its prospecting, digging, or mining, operations shall pay to the said G.W. Hawkins for any growing crop it may injure, in event an agreement can not be made between the parties to be left to three disinterested appraisers, one to be named by each party, and the third one to be agreed upon between the two appraisers so named, such appraisal to be made within thirty days after any dispute arises, and in event either party should fail to name an appraiser upon five days notice given either party, the appraiser named by such party may alone make assessment of damages, and his finding shall be final.

Together with the right of ingress, egress, and regress for itself, its agents, servants, employees, successors or assigns, to any and every acre, of the said land which it may use for the purpose of mining.

To have and to hold, all and singular, the said right and privilege as hereinbefore mentioned, unto the said Carolina Monazite Co., its successors and assigns for the said period.

And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Carolina Monazite Co., for the said period aforesaid, against me and my heirs and against all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
