TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. D. Davis Heirs and Assigns forever.

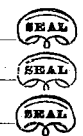
And do hereby bind Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. D. Davis
