Bomar of the County of Greenville South Carolina

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A.J. Bomar all that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on the head waters of South Tiger River Beginning at a stake in the Bramlett Road on D.B. Jacksons line thence N. 64 3/4 W. 8.50 ch. to a stone thence S. 13 1/4 W. 5.00 ch. to a stone thence S. 14 1/2 E. 4.50 ch. to a stone thence S. 32 E. 8.10 ch. to the Bramlett Road thence along said Road to the Beginning corner. Containing ten (10) acres more or less. Containing ten (10) acres more or less Adjoining lands of Dr. D.B. Jackson and others.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said A.J. Bomar and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves and our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said A.J. Bomar and his

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
