(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mattie J. Earle all that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land

situate lying and being in the first ward of the City of Greenville in said State and County on the East side of Hampton Avenue (formerly named West Street and afterwards Highland Avenue) having a frontage of seventy (70) feet on said Avenue, and a uniform width of seventy feet throughout its entire depth of two hundred and ten (210) feet more or less, along parallel lines containing 14,700 square feet more or less bounded on the East by lot belonging to Boyd and on the west by lot belonging to D.S. Miller the lot hereby conveyed being the same which

conveyed to me the said Stephen King by T.F. Simpson by Deed bearing date June 5th 1902 and duly recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesme Conveyance for said State and County on July 2nd 1902 in Deed book I.I.I. at page 772;

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Mattie J. Earle and her Heirs and Assigns forever

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Mattie J. Earle and her

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
