One hundred and eighty feet to a large gate post on a twelve foot alley; thence along said alley N. 52 1/2 W. One hundred and sixty-one feet to a stake on Crown Street; thence along Crown Street S. 21 W. Two hundred and fourteen feet to the beginning, containing 30927 square feet, more or less.
