following lines, metes and bounds, to-wit; Beginning at a
stake on the East side of Brown Street and running thence
along the line of my lots fronting North Street 8.68 ft. One
hundred and fifty-three feet to a stake in R. Eludel's
line, thence along this line 21 ft. One hundred and
eighty feet to a large gate post on a twelve foot alley
thence along said alley 27.52 $\frac{1}{3}$ ft. One hundred and sixty
one feet to a stake on Brown Street; thence along Brown
Street 8.21 ft. Two hundred and fourteen feet to the
beginning, containing 30927 square feet, more or less,
