(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. A. Holland all that certain parcel or strips of land in Ward One, Greenville City, said County and State, on Putler Avenue, beginning at the South rear corner of his lot and extending in the exact course thereof eight (8) feet; thence by a line just passing by the Northern side of a mulberry tree on my lot, and directly toward a point on Putler Ave, just three and one half feet (3 1/2 ft) north of my front corner, but to which point said W. A. Holland has this day deeded me a small strip of land in order to straighten and adjust more conveniently the line between our lots, conformable to the plat hereon appearing

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. A. Holland, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind me and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. A. Holland, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
