(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John W. Washington all that piece of land

or lot of land situate in Ward Four in the City and County of Greenville and State of South Carol in a on the South side of Cash Mcbee Avenue, being known as lot number twelve of T. L. Cleveland's Mcbee Avenue addition with lines and corners following: Beginning at an iron stake on the South side of Mcbee Avenue near the intersection of said Avenue with Washington Street on the North east corner of lot number Eleven of said addition and running thence with Mcbee Avenue $N. 69^{\circ} 10' E.$ seventy-eight feet to an iron pin stake, thence $S. 14^{\circ} 15' E.$ one hundred and seventy-five feet to an iron stake on an alley, then with said alley $S. 69^{\circ} 10' W.$ Seventy-eight feet to an iron stake, thence $N. 14^{\circ} 15' W.$ One hundred and seventy-five feet to the Beginning corner,
