KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. G. Leslie and M. A. G. Leslie, v. the County of Greenville, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to us, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. G. McClellan.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. G. McClellan, his Heirs and Assigns, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the City and County of Greenville, in said State, beginning at a point in the West line of North Main Street (directly in centre line of Main Street, culvert) and running thence with said West line of Main street S. 19° W. One hundred and one feet to a stake near a large white oak tree (the North side of said tree being the line) N. 71° W. One hundred and seventy-five feet to a stake in L. G. Leslie's garden, thence bounded with Main street N. 19° E. Ninety-six feet to a point in a line with the centre of Main street culvert and Townes street culvert; thence to the point of beginning. This last named line is supposed to be the central line of branch when straightened.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said G. G. McClellan, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind Ourselves, Our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said G. G. McClellan, his

Heirs and Assigns, against Ourselves and Our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
