(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Albert Pitman all of that certain piece of land or tract of land situate lying and being in Saluda Township in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on a Branch of

Mush Creek, waters of South Tyger River and is part of a tract of land owned by Robert Pitman at the time of his death and known in the division as tract No. 7 and runs as follows: Beginning on a P. oak 3 x and runs; thence S. 4 W. 5. 90 chs to a stone 3 x near a persimmon tree; thence S. 22 1/4 E. 7. chs. to stone 3 x; thence S. 6 E. 15. 90 to a stone 3 x on tract No. 3. line; thence N. 6. 40 ch. to a stone 3 x on Bridge-road; thence down said road to Forks of old and new road 3 x; thence up old road to the Beginning 3 x containing 11 1/4 acres.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Albert Pitman, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Albert Pitman, his

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
