Power of Attorney

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I Susan MONTAGUE BULL, nee CALDWELL, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint, my mother Agnes Montague CALDWELL of Greenville, South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place and stead to enter into and take possession of all such lands, tenements, hereditaments and real estate whatever in the State of South Carolina, and especially in the city of Greenville, to or in which I may be or am interested or entitled in any way; and to grant, bargain and sell and convey the same or any part or parcel thereof for such sum or price, and on such terms, as to her shall seem meet: and for me and in my name, to execute, acknowledge and deliver good and sufficient deeds and conveyances ~~for~~ for the same, either with or without covenants and warranty, and until the sale thereof, to let and demise the said real estate, for the best rent that can be procured for the same, and to ask, demand, distrain for, collect, recovery and receive all sums of money which shall become due and owing to me, by means of such bargain and sale, or lease and demise, giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and preform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done, in and about the premises as fully, to all intents and purpose, as I might or could do if personally present with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or her substitute shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue thereof
