(Agreement or Assignment 75 C.)

Whereas on the 16th, day of December 1904 a contract was entered into between J.E. Alexander of said County and George L. English of Shelby, North Carolina, for the mining of Monozite on lands of said J.E. Alexander in said County:

And Whereas the said George L. English was at that time employed by the National Light & Thorium Company, a corporation of the State of Delaware, and said contract was taken for their use and benefit although in the name of said George L. English whose intention it was to transfer said contract and assign the same to said Company.

And Whereas no formal assignment has been made although said Company is the actual owner of said contract and the holder thereof and has been since the date of its execution, and said George L. English has never claimed an individual interest therein.

Now therefore Know all men by these presents, that in consideration of the premises, and for other valuable consideration received of said Company above and also hereinafter named, I the said George L. English have assigned, transferred and set over, and do hereby assign, transfer and set over unto said National Light and Thorium Company, a corporation as aforesaid, its successors and assigns forever, the said contract above mentioned which has been recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in book M.M.M. page 359.
