Durrett on the delivery of this deed, the receipt of which said sum is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the Second part, her heirs and assigns all the right, title and Claim which they or either of them may have in and to the Real-Estate in Greenville County, South Carolina. Described as follows, to wit:

Lots numbered six and eight in Block "G" having a frontage on Second Avenue of One hundred feet and depth of One hundred and fifty feet in Park Place, an addition to the City of Greenville, South Carolina, situated just out side of the City limits of Greenville as shown in revised plat of said addition on file in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance for said Greenville County Plat book "A" page 119 and being the same property described in the deed of J.W.
