Donaldson, my Attorney in fact, in consideration of One Thousand and thirty-nine dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by F. C. Bright of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said F. C. Bright, All those certain lots or parcels of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina in what is known as Park Place, near the City of Greenville, a revised Plat of which is of Record in the Register of Mesne Conveyance office for the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina in Plat Book A at page 119, said lots being Numbers 10, 12, 14, 16 & 18 on said revised Plat in Block J and a part of the tract of land which was sold and conveyed to J. W. Cagle T. Q. Donaldson and William Wilkins by Alexander Stewart and Jacob H. Susong by deed bearing date 21st, March 1890, and recorded in book V. V., at page 651 in R. M. C. office in and for Greenville County in the State of South Carolina, and a part of the same tract which includes the lot herein conveyed, sold and conveyed to me by J. W. Cagle, T. Q.
