KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT THE CITY ^{Council} OF GREENVILLE, in The State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Dollars, to it in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Joseph E. Leach (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph E. Leach Lot No 270 of SPRINGWOOD CEMETARY having the following dimensions to wit:- Eleven feet long by eleven feet wide for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purposes aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and By-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery ~~and the burial of the dead therein.~~

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph E. Leach his heirs and assigns forever, subject however to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.

And it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph E. Leach his heirs and assigns against itself and its successors in office, claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

WITNESS the seal of the said City Council of Greenville, this 27th day of March A.D. 1894, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four and in the one hundred and 18th year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
