Dolars, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by O.P. Mills of Greenville County in the State aforesaid of South Carolina the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said O.P. Mills and his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville and State of South Carolina, in Cleveland Township, on the head waters of Middle Saluda River, on both sides of the Ceaser's Head road and Jones Gap road, adjoining the lands of O.P. Mills and others and more particularly described as follows: to wit, Beginning on a stone on the Blue Ridge, South of Blythe's Gap Southe-West corner of the George Salmon's grant and runs with the line of said grant, S 56 E 35. chs to a stake on a ridge; thence up and with said ridge the following courses and distances; to wit: S 19 E 4 chs; thence S 8.00 E 6 chs, thence S 47 E 1.25 chs; thence S 80 E. 4.50 thence N 30 E - ~~4.50 thence N 50 E. 2 chs~~; thence N.59 E 1.50 to a stake on the Blue Ridge, the State line, thence along the Blue Ridge the following courses and distances; N 19 E 6.50 N 8 E 1.50 - 1.50. N 3 W. 6.50 chs N 6 E 1.50 N 30 W 7 chs, N 7-1/2 3.50 N 71 W. 6.50 S 70 W 2.00; S 40. W. 2.00 S 70 W 1.50 to a stake in the road in Jones Gap thence N 43 W 0.50 to a stone in State line on the west side of the road; thence N 68 west 4.87 chs; N 28 W 1.75 N 8 W. 1.00 N 7-1/2 W 1.00; N 8-1/2 W. 2.00; N 1-1/2 W 3.25 chs N. 46 W 2.50; N 52 W 2.00; N 75 W 3.00 N 48 W 2.00 to a stake and pointers on said Blue Ridge in the west boundary line of said George Salmon's grant; thence with said line S 25 W 16.50 chs to the beginning. containing sixty-five (65) acres more or less, the family burial ground not exceeding one-half acre and a right of way to the same is hereby reserved to the grantors and thier heirs,

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said O.P. Mills and his heirs and assigns forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said O.P. Mills and his heirs and assigns, against ourselves and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
