yield and render each to the other, a true, just and perfect inventory and accounts of all profits and increase by them or either of them <sup>made</sup> and of all losses ~~of~~ them or either of them sustained and also, all payments and receipts, disbursements and all other things by them made received disbursed, acted upon, done or suffered in this said copartnership and business and the same account so made, shall and will clear, adjust, pay and deliver, each to the other, at the time, their just share of the profits and pay and bear their just share of the expenses and losses so made as aforesaid.

5. It is agreed that each of the said parties may draw from the cash of the said copartnership the sum of Ten Dollars, weekly to his own use, the same to be charged in account and neither of them shall take any further sum for his own separate use, without the consent of the other in writing.

6. And the said parties hereby mutually covenant and agree, to and with each other, that during the continuance of their copartnership, neither of them shall nor will indorse any note, or otherwise become surity for any persons or persons without the consent of the other of the said copartners, and at the determination of the said copartnership the said copartners, each to the other, shall and will make a true, just and final account of all things relating to the said business and in all things truly adjust the same and, all and every, the stock and stocks as well as the gains and increase thereof which shall appear to be remaining, either in money, goods, wares, fixtures, debts of otherwise, shall be divided between them.

7. Should either of the said copartners desire to terminate this copartnership, he shall have the privilege of so doing, by giving to the other of the said copartners ninety days notice, in writing, of his intention so to do.
