Stone, of Aiken County and Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the premises and of the sum of One hundred dollars to us in hand paid by the Southern Power Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Southern Power Company its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of Griffin, Gwinn, Bruns, Gerraux, C.B. Stone, Bradley, Swing, Jennings, Goodlett and Whorley, said land being known as the Croft Farm.

And to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises in a proper manner with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose, of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.
