P. P. P.

4th. To pay from the proceeds of said sales all expenses incident to making the same and conveying said lands including the expense of drawing and executing this deed, but he is not to receive any compensation for himself, he having agreed to execute the trusts herein created without compensation.

5th., After making said payments to divide the remainder of the proceeds of such sale or sales among us equally.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said lands unto the said J.W. Norwood, his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
