Chandler both of the State and County aforesaid, have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain sell, and release unto the S.V. Chandler and K.S. Chandler.

All the interest that I have in all of the real-estate of Josiah Chandler, deceased, late of the State and County aforesaid, except Ninety-two acres owned by Elizabeth Chandler the Widow of said deceased, bounded by lands of H. Sullivan, Hopkins, Ware and others. TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said interest belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to S.V. Chandler K.S. Chandler.

To have and to hold all and singular the interest before mentioned unto the aforesaid Chandlers, their heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said interest unto the aforesaid Chandler, their interest to their heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
