consigned instruments on hand and in transit, and that it will deliver said instruments on demand to the party of the first part properly boxed and packed, and in as good condition as when received by the party of the second part; that while said instruments are in the possession, the party of the second part shall keep them fully insured in the name of the party of the first part and for its benefit; that it will pay all freight, cartage, rental of premises in which such instruments are kept, and expenses of and every kind and nature whatsoever incurred on account of the transportation, delivery, handling and sale of such instruments. Fifth.— This agreement may be terminated at any time by the written notice of either party as regarded to the consignment of goods, but all other conditions are to remain in full force and effect until any settlement under this contract is completed according to the provisions contained therein.
