Received from Postal Telegraph Cable Co. Thirty-Five ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, \$ 35⁰⁰ in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct and maintain its lines of Telegraph including the necessary poles and fixtures, over the property which I own, or in which I have any interest, in the Township of Dunklin County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim all trees necessary to keep the wires cleared at least eighteen inches, to set necessary guy and brace poles, and to attach to trees the necessary guy wires. Part of line to be built along road and not to exceed 4 feet from road line. Part is to cross field any damage done to growing crops to be paid for at Market Value in addition to the amount mentioned in this contract.
