Received from Postal Telegraph Cable Co. Fifteen ^{and} \$100 Dollars \$15⁰⁰ in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct and maintain its lines of Telegraph including the necessary poles and fixtures, over the property which I own, or in which I have any interest in the Township of Dunklin County of Greenville and State of South Carolina and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim all trees necessary to keep the wires cleared at least eighteen inches, to set necessary guy and brace poles, and to attach to trees the necessary guy wires. Line to be built along road, poles to be set so as not to interfere with getting in and out of building and roads, any damage done to crops to be paid for at market value.
