Received from Postal Telegraph Cable Co. Five $\frac{24}{100}$ Dollars, $\$5 \frac{24}{100}$ in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct and maintain its lines of Telegraph, including the necessary poles and fixtures, over the property which I own, or in which I have any interest, in the Township of Gantt County of Greenville and State of S. C. and along the roads, streets, or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim all trees necessary to keep the wires cleared at least eighteen inches, to set necessary guy and brace poles, and to attach to these the necessary guy wires. One pole line only, line to be constructed as near to road as possible, east side road.
