 County of Greenville and State of South
 Carolina and upon and along the roads, streets
 or highways adjoining the said property; said
 sum is received in full payment for said
 right, and also for the right to permit the
 attachment of the wires of any other company
 or person to said poles and fixtures, and the
 right to trim and cut trees along said
 lines so as to clear and to keep the wires
 cleared at least 25 feet, and the right to
 cut all trees that in falling would reach
 the wires, and the further right to erect and
 set the necessary guy and brace poles and
 anchors, and to attach thereto and to trees
 the necessary guy wires; said sum being
 received in full payment thereof. The above
 amount is received in full payment and
 satisfaction for all damages.
