\$5 00 Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, Five dollars, in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own, or in which I have any interest, in the Township of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and upon and along the roads, streets, or highways adjoining the said property with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least eighteen inches, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors and to attach thereto and to the necessary guy wires, said sum being received in full payment therefor. compensation in full for all past damage said company agrees to pay damage done trees and crops maintaining said line in the future.
