The National Light and Thorium Co., is hereby authorized to take and remove all Monozite sand in the bed of Bakers Creek, on my land in Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, adjoining lands of Eliza Cureton, access to the Creek to be had only over the Cureton land. This permission shall last as long as the Company maintains proper drainage in the Creek, but shall terminate with the death of L.B. Waldrop, so far as possible the company shall throw out the wash material on the Waldrop side of the Creek no ditch shall be run on the Waldrop land.
