 Certificate of Incorporation,
 WHEREAS, C.E. Graham, W.M. McPhectus, S.C. Byrd, W.G. Neville, E.P. Davis, T.D. Cartledge,
 J.F. Jagood, W.P. Nesbitt & M.F. Ansel, two or more of the officers or agents appointed to
 supervise or manage the affairs of The Board of Trustees of Chicora College, a----- which
 has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 30th, day of May, A.D., 1906, file with
 the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth; That a meeting of the aforesaid
 organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they
 were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation. That the said organization holds, n
 or desires to hold, property in common for a Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal,
 Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is
 not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members; otherwise than is above stat-
 ed, or for the insurance of life, health, accident, or property; and that three days
 notice in the Greenville daily Herald, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville,
 has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed. AND WHEREAS, That said Dec-
 larants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed: First their names and residences
 are as above given, Second, the name of the proposed Corporation is The Board of Trustees
 of Chicora College. Third the place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or
 be located is Greenville, S.C. Fourth the purpose of the said proposed Corporation is,
 Section 1, That the persons elected as hereinafter prescribed, and their Successors in
 office, be and they are hereby created and constituted a body politic and corporate, by
 the name and style of, ("The Board of Trustees of Chicora College"). Section 2, Corporate
 rights, the said Board shall by said name have perpetual succession of members and officers,
 the right to use and keep a common seal; and the same to be altered at will; and may sue and
 be sued, plead and be impleaded; and may own and purchase, lease and mortgage, sell and
 convey property, both real, personal and mixed; and may receive, hold and administer
 donations, devises, bequestes and legacies for the use and benefit of the said Chicora-
 College: Provided (1) That all property owned, purchased or received by donation, devise
 bequest, or legacies shall be taken in the name of the Board in its Corporate capacity and
 shall become the property of the Presbyteries of Bethel, Enoree and South Carolina and
 any other one or more Presbyteries not herein named of the Synod of S.C. in connection
 with the Presbyterian Church in the United States: (2) , That no property given, devised
 bequeathed, or conveyed to the said Board shall be used or disposed of contrary to
 the conditions annexed to any such gift, devise, bequest,, or conveyance. Section (3)
 Objects, The main object of the said Board of Trustees shall be to govern and control,
 under the limitations of this Charter, and Institution of Learning for white female
 Youth for the purpose of promoting Christian education in harmony with the constitution
 of the Presbyterian Church in the United States. Section (4) Membership/ The said Board
 shall consist of four persons from each of the said Presbyteries of Bethel, Enoree and
 South Carolina and of any other of the Presbyteries of the said Synod of South Carolina,
 the same to be office bearers in the churches of the said Presbyteries and to be elected
 by the Presbytery and er whose jurisdiction they severally are. In case any Presbytery or
 Presbyteries shall fail to elect said members, appointment to fill the vacancy shall be
 made by the remaining members of the Board in annual meeting assembled: Provided, that
 such appointment shall hold good only until the Presytery or Presbyteries shall elect as
 above prescribed. Section (5), Terms of office, The regular term of office of the members
 of the said Board shall be four years, but the first four members elected by each
 Presbytery shall serve, one for one year, one for two years, one for three years, and
 one for four years. The terms of office shall date from the first day of July. The
 Presbyteries shall hold an election at their regular spring meetings every year to fill
 vacancies as they occur by expiration of the terms of office. Section (6), Officers. The
 officers of the said Board shall be a President, a Vice-President and a Secretary. The Board
 shall elect for itself a Treasurer and an Attorney, both of whom shall be from its own
 member, or from the Presbyteries at large. The said Treasurer shall give a suitable Bond
 for the faithful discharge of his trust, (1) To govern and control, under the limitations
 of this charter the said Chicora College; (2), to make laws, rules and regulations for
 its own government and the proper administration of the trust committed to it, for the
 Government of the said College and for the preservation of order and good morals therein,
 not inconsistent with the laws of South Carolina, or the laws of the United States, or
 the provisions of this Charter; (3) To administer all trust funds for the benefit
 of the said College, according to the terms of bequest, or in case of the absence of such
 terms according to its judgement; (4) To control the financial affairs of the said College
 Provided, that the payment of salaries and wages of teachers and employees, the expendi-
 tures for repairs and improvements and any other current or special expense shall not be
 made a claim upon the real estate, endowment or any other permanent trust fund of the
 college; (5) To, elect, a President, a Vice-President and such Professors, Tutors and
 other of ficers for the said College as it may think proper for a successful operation: The
 President, Vice-President and Professors shall constitute the faculty of the said College
 (6) To grant diplomas and to confer and award all such meritorious and honorary degrees,
 distinctions and testimonials as are usually conferred by literary colleges, seminaries
 and universities in the United States: (7) To appoint an executive Committee to consist of
 not more than seven members of the said Board, The said Executive Committee shall have the
 right , during the intervals between the meetings of the Board of Trustees to exercise all
 the power, Privileges and prerogatives of the said Board, except such as are expressly
 reserved to the Board by the Charter or by itself: And during the said interim all the
 officers of the said corporation, and of said College, shall be under the control and
 direction of said Executive Committee. All the Acts of the said Executive Committee shall
 be subject to the review and control of the said Board of Trustees; (8) To change the same
 and title of the Body, politic and corporate, hereby created, In case of such change of
 name and title the new body politic and corporate shall succeed to all the rights, powers,
 privileges and advantages conferred by this Charter upon the Board of Trustees of Chicora-
 College, to change the name or location, or both name and location, of the said College with
 the concurrence of two-thirds of the Presbyteries having rightful possession of the said
 College. In case of such change of name or location, or both name and location of the
 said College the new College shall succeed to all the rights, powers, privileges and
 advantages of Chicora College. Section (8). Special duties. The said Board of Trustees shall
 be charges (1) To keep a full and accurate record of all its meetings and business and to
 submit the same when requested to do so, for review by any or all of the owning
