## Articles of Agreement,

Made this November 13th., 1906, by and between the Mountaineer Publishing Company, and the Piedmont Publishing Company, both of Greenville, S. C. Witnesseth:

1. That the said Mountaineer Publishing Company does hereby sell and convey to The Piedmont Publishing Company the name, subscription list and good will of the news paper known as "The Mountaineer", heretofore published by us, in consideration of the sum of \$1,000, to be paid as follows: \$100 in cash upon the actual transfer of the paper, and \$300 within four months after the date of the transfer, and \$300 within eight months thereafter, and \$300 in twelve months thereafter. And in the event of the failure to pay any one of the said instalments when due, the entire balance shall at once become due and payable, and the lien for the purchase price of said paper at once be subject to foreclosure, and any sums already paid under this contract shall at once be applied in full of rent and liquidated damages for the breach of this contract.

2. That The Mountaineer Publishing Company reserves to itself all accounts now due for subscriptions or advertisements which The Mountaineer Publishing Company has collected for in advance.
