Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, Two & xx Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its, successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures, upon, over and across the property within which I own, or in which I have any interest, in the Township of Chick-Springs, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and upon and along the roads, Streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to permit the attachments of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least eighteen inches, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors and to attach thereto and to trees the necessary guy wires, said sum being received in full payment therefor.
