The Lessess agrees to keep the building and all the fixtures thereinin good repair, and at the end of the term herein provided, to surrender the same in good condition, provided however, that the lessesshall not be responsible for any demage or laces that may be occasioned by fire, cyclone and earthquake.

It is agreed that this lease shall not be assigned, or the premises sublet, except with the written consent of the lessor, provided, however, this shall not preclude the lessees from renting or leasing rooms in the said premises if it shall be thought advisable to do so.

It is agreed that each of the parties hereto can insure their respective premises, or by mutual agreement joint insurance can be taken out for their memutual protection.

And in case the lessor should at any time during the continuance of this lease, determine to sell said property, it will give to the lessees and their Successors, the option to purchase the same at the highest price that it can obtain.
