Dear Sir:

Recognizing that by the expenditure of money and labor, you have demonstrated the actual cost of mining Mica on our Lands, and demonstrated the value of the Mica by Sales in the open market, we acting individually and jointly, agree to the following amendments to our agreements with you, made under date of September 29th, 1909, November 22nd, 1909, November 27th, 1909 and we make this further agreement, without prejudice to the contracts above named, and recognize that such amendments and further agreements will be of financial benefit to us.

Relating to those parts of the above named agreements and contracts, covering the payment by you to us of ten (10%) per cent of the gross value received by you for all minerals taken from our lands, as royalty to us, we agree as follows, to wit:

That on all Mica mined and classified by splitting, thumb trimming and knife trimming, and sold to manufactures of Mica, we are to receive ten (10%) per cent of the amount of money received by you for such classified Mica.

That on all Mica mined and sold as Mica ore, unclassified, screened and dirt and waste removed, we are to receive the sum of Two and 50/100 (\$2.50) dollars per ton as royalty or purchase price, this purchase price or royalty to be paid to us when the Mica ore is removed from our land.

That on all Mica mined and sold as waste Mica, we are to receive ten (10%) per cent of the Gross amount of money received by you for such waste Mica, waste Mica being defined as such as is sold for grinding and insulating purposes.

This letter and its agreement to become a part of our agreements with you, dated September 29th, 1909, November 22nd, 1909 and November 27th, 1909.
