Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, of South Carolina Five 00/100 Dollars, in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own, or in which I have any interest, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and upon and along the roads, Streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said line so as to keep the wires cleared at least eighteen inches to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors and to attach thereto and to trees the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor, and in full compensation for the erection and maintenance of guy with the agreement that said guy shall be relocated to conform with futur improvements and that the said Company shall pay any damage to drain pipes caused by the erection of said guy.
