Smith - running thence N. 61-1/2° W. 22 chains to a stone corner with said M. A. Smith in Prof. Hubbard's line - thence N. 24-3/4° E. 5.10 chains to a stone corner with said Hubbard - thence S. 57-3/4 E. 13.50 chains to a white oak stump on north side of branch - thence S. 57-1/2 E. 11.50 chs. to a stake in said road corner with Jerry Smith - thence S. 74-1/2 W. 1.80 ch. to a corner in said road - thence S. 52 1/2 W. 2.40 ch. to the beginning, containing ten acres more or less.
