County and State aforesaid on North side of Pinckney Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit; beginning at an iron pin on said Pinckney street and running thence with Pinckney Street N. 37 W. forty-seven (47) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 57 E. one hundred and two and one-half (102-1/2) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 37 E. forty-seven (47) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57 W. one hundred and two and one half (102-1/2) feet to beginning corner, the lot now conveyed known as lot # 10 on plat made by John M. Curleon, Surveyor, October 13th., 1903 and being lot bought by us from Mary C. - Armstrong, and recorded in Volume O.O.O. page 233 in R.M.C. office for Greenville County.

Heirs and Assigns, against ourselves and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
