the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paris Mountain Water Company, all my undivided interest in all that piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South-Carolina, on waters of Mountain Creek, containing Seventeen acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to wit; Beginning at a black-gum 3X and running; thence N. 73-1/2 E. 6.00 ch. to stake; thence S. 69-1/2 W. 5.50 ch. to Hickory; thence N. 22-1/2 E. 13.00 ch. to Mountain Creek; thence up Mountain Creek to the Western line of the Green Pool Lands and; thence S. 22-1/2 W. 22.75 ch. to the beginning, being the tract conveyed by Hampton P. Pool and others to Paris Mountain Water Company by deed dated Oct. 7th, 1890, recorded in R.M.C. office book W.W. 429 in which my interest was not included.

TOGETHER will all and singular the Rights, Members, Heraditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said grantee, its successors Heirs and Assigns forever

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said grantee, its successors

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.


