Cureton all that certain piece or lot of land situate in the City and County of Greenville and State of South Carolina on the south side of Washington Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:- Beginning at a stake on Washington Street 129 feet east of Heldman Street at the corner of lot belonging to J. A. Cureton and P. F. Cureton and running thence with said Washington Street S. 71 E. fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence S. 17 1/2 W. one hundred and eighty (180) feet to stake; thence N. 71 W. fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence N. 17 1/2 E. one hundred and eighty (180) feet to the beginning corner.

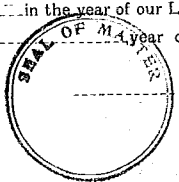
