the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. Lee Green, Guardian in Trust for Eleanor Alexander, nee Cole, Sarah E. Cole,

J. Lee Cole, J.B. Cole, and Elrenza G. Cole, the share of each being an undivided one-seventh

interest in of or to all that certain parcel or tract of land, situate, in Chick Springs Township County and State aforesaid; known as Tract No. 3 in the survey of the lands for partition of Edward S. Green, deceased, containing sixty-two and three-fourths (62-3/4) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

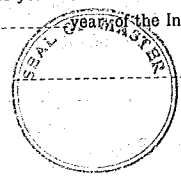
