NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, J. W. GRAY, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and ten Dollars, to me paid by the said

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Elias Earle, M.D. Earle, W.L. Gassoway, their heirs and assigns, all that piece,

parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known as lot No. 5 of the property of the Estate of John K. Earle, bounded by Pendleton new cut Street known as Sumner Street, and Garlington Street, sold by the Master for Greenville on Sales-day in May, 1906, having the following notes and bounds, to wit; commencing on a stake corner Garlington and new cut Street known as Sumner Street and running; thence along Garlington Street S. 71 R. 182 feet to a stake corner of Garlington street and 20 foot alley running from said Garlington Street, parallel with Sumner Street 184 feet to back line of lot No. 1; thence along the line of said alley N. 18 E. 61-1/3 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 4; thence along the line of lot No. 4, N. 71 W. 182-3/4 feet to stake on Sumner Street, S.W. corner of lot No. 4, thence along Sumner Street 61-1/3 feet to the beginning corner, with the right of way and use for exit to and entrance from Garlington Street along the above 20 foot alley, courses and distances taken from survey and plat made by John M.
