the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Laurens M. Gray,

All that parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on South side of Echols St, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, commencing on N.W. corner of lot of J.W. Gray, and running N. with Echols St, sixty-eight and one third (68 1/3) feet to ten foot alley running at right angles with said Echols St, thence along said alleyway in a southerly direction to ten foot alley, running parallel with Echols St, into Buncombe St, seventy-five (75) feet to stake; thence Easterly along said alleyway sixty-eight and one third (68 1/3) feet to a stake; thence along the line of J.W. Gray's lot seventy-five (75) feet to the beginning corner, being a part of lot 1 of which Lewis Slowe, deceased, died seized and possessed,
