the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.B. Moore, all that piece, parcel, or tract of land situate lying and being

in the County and State aforesaid, and known as tract No4 of my real estate, and more fully described in the said deed above referred to, and recorded in the office of R.M.C., for said County Book "AAA", page 517; containing one hundred and eleven and seventy-eight hundredths acres, (111-78/100) more or less, being the same land intended to be deeded to the said W.B. Moore by the above referred to deed.

TOGETHER will all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W.B. Moore, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said W.B. Moore, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
