of Enoree River and Brushy Creek and bounded by lands of Pelham Manufacturing Company, B.F. Trapier and containing eighty-four (84) acres, more or less, known as the Sidduth place, and nine (9) acres obtained on an exchange with Pelham Manufacturing Co., on account of Back water making 93 ninety-three acres, more or less in tract and not including 5 1/3 Five & 1/3 acres sold to B.F. Trapier and was sold off the Sidduth Place.
