parcel of land lying and being in Glassy Mountain Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, bounded as follows: beginning at a Sweet Gum on public road, thence west to a stone, thence south to a stone, thence east to a stone thence along public road to beginning corner, supposed to be one acre, more or less, surrounded by lands of R.P. Pitman

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mount Pleasant Baptist Church, Deacons and thier successors in office heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mount Pleasant Baptist Church Deacons

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
