 WHEREAS, on Aug. 31st, 1907 (Deed rec rded P.P.F. page 141) We, the undersigned, made a deed to J.T. Doster to the Lots of land hereinafter mentioned and described, and whereas, said lots were in-accurately described, and whereas there were no words of inheritance in said Deed, but it was our intention to convey to the said J.T. Doster, his heirs and assigns forever, the lots of land hereinafter described, and whereas we, now desire to correct said deed.
 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Chas. A. Senn, Mrs. C.J. Goodrich and Mrs. Mary Doster of Birmingham, Ala. and Mrs. Elizabeth Tindall of Birmingham, Ala. and T.J. Senn of Newport, R.I. sole heirs at-law and distributees of Mrs. N.E. Senn, deceased, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.T. Doster of Birmingham, Ala (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.T. Doster his heirs and assigns forever. All our right, title and interest in and to all those two lots of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, on Hayne Street, and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Hayne St. at the South-west corner of Thruston's line; thence N. 14 W. 202 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on Thruston's corner; thence S. 79-45 W. 111 feet, more or less with Thruston's line to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 4; thence with the line of Lot No. 4 S. 13-37 E. 100.5 feet to an iron pin in center of alley; thence with said alley N. 79.52 E. 11.5 feet to alley and lot No. 2; thence with said alley S. 14 E. 100.5 feet to an iron pin on Hayne Street; thence with said Hayne Street N. 80 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, and being known and described as Lots Nos. 2 and 3 on Plat recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. HHY, page 830, and being the same lots of land previously conveyed by the said J.T.
