Power of Attorney

Know all men by these presents, that I, Alexander K. Manos, of the City of Sparta, in the Kingdom of Greece, do hereby appoint and constitute, John K. Manos, of the City of Anderson, in the State of South Carolina, in the United States of America, for me and in my stead, as my true and lawful attorney in fact, to demand, sue for, receive, receipt for all rents and profits from my real-estate situate in Greenville, in the aforesaid State of South Carolina; to take and use all lawful means for terminating rent contracts and ejecting objectionable or delinquent renters or occupants, from all of any of my premises aforesaid.

To contract with prospective or present tenants as to the use and occupancy of my said premises; to make, draw, sign, indorse in my name any cheques or bills of exchange in which I may be interested in connection therewith.

I further empower him, the said John K. Manos, my attorney in fact, to keep insured any of my premises aforesaid, against fire, to pay the premiums, and to collect and receipt for insurance in the event of fire. I further empower him to keep repaired all of my said premises as repairs may be needed, and to pay for the same out of rents and profits of said premises.

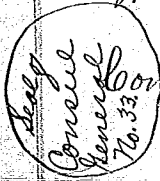
