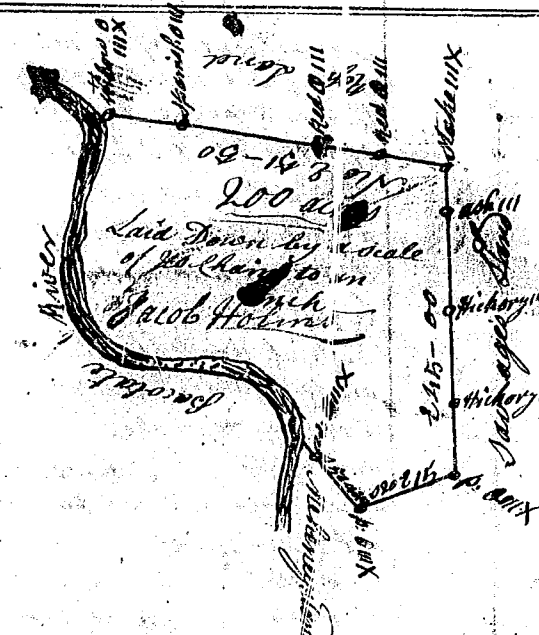
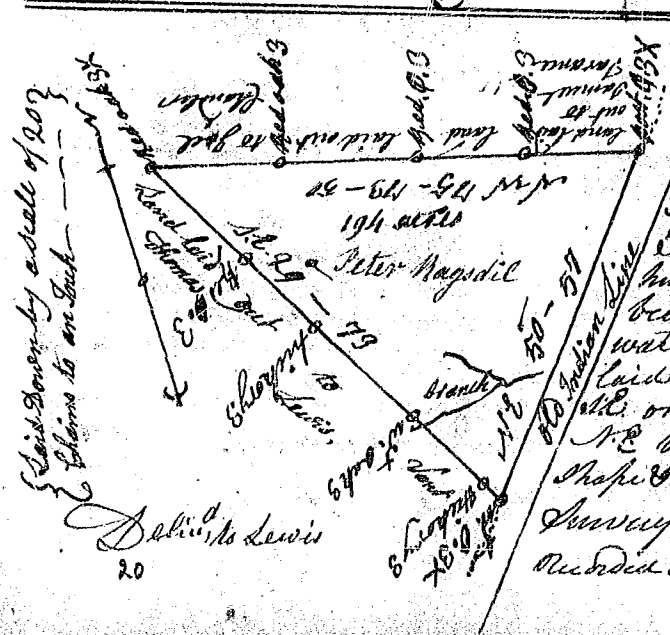

 unto Jacob Holmes a tract of land in Ninety
 Six District on the south side of Saluda
 River bounded to the North by said
 River, and on every other side by
 land containing the quantity of Two
 Hundred acres and hath such other
 shape and marks as the above plat represents
 Surveyed the Ninth day of July 1784
