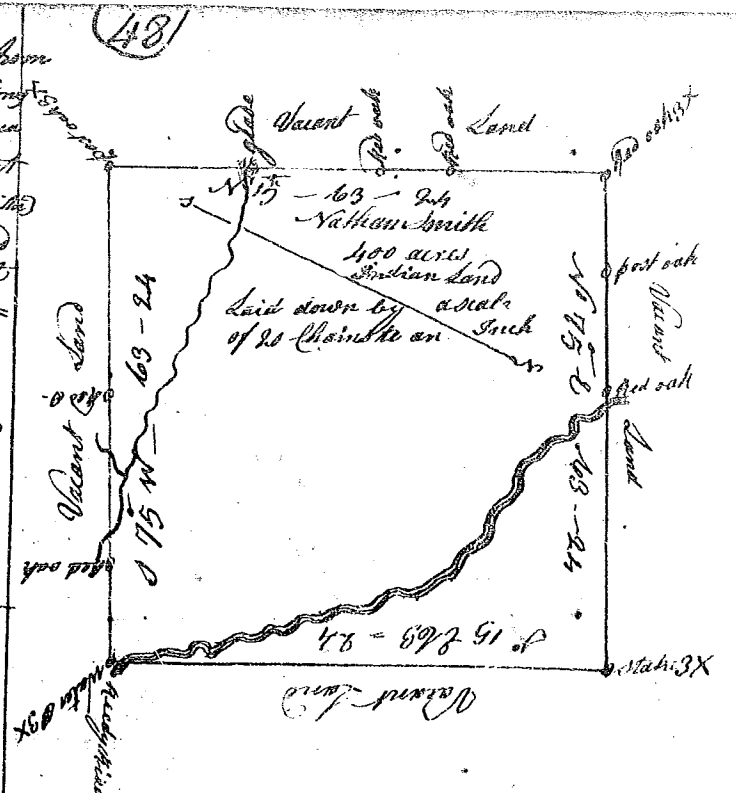


State of South Carolina

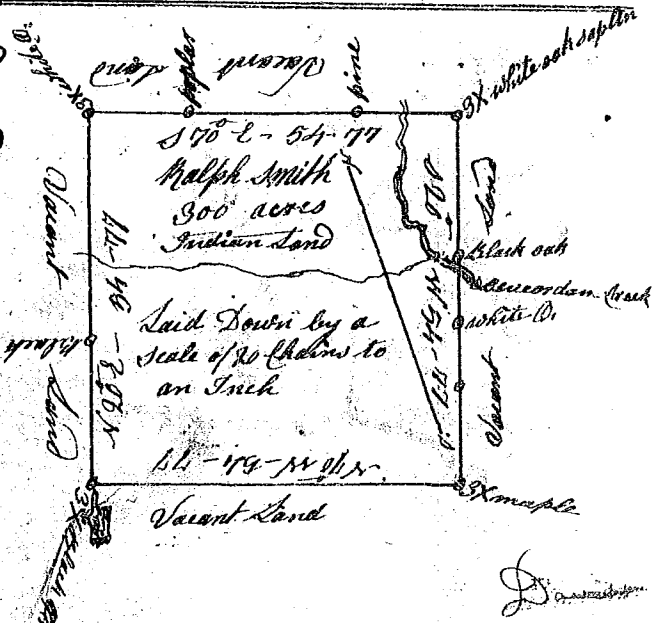
